Ron Lovin will be performing your favorite Classic Country and Golden Oldies.

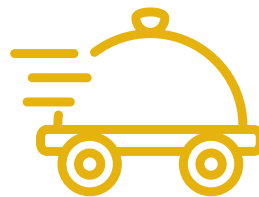
