

JOHN 4:15-42

SERMON SUMMARY

Each of us is a sinner, separated from God, in need of some solution to make us right with Him. Jesus shows us that he is that solution. He is the only way to God. When sinners encounter Jesus and trust in Him, their lives are changed forever, and they become messengers who tell others about Him.

QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER

- What are some examples from your own life of preconceived ideas about Jesus, which have been shattered over time?
- Why is exposure of sin necessary? How is it an evidence of grace?
- What does Jesus teach us about true worship in this passage? Why is proper worship only possible through Him? What does this mean for people all over the world who don't follow Jesus?
- How is Christianity both inclusive and exclusive? How does this affect our relationship with unbelievers?
- How does this passage encourage you in evangelism?
- How do the Samaritans in this passage demonstrate authentic faith?

PRAYER PROMPTS

- Praise God our Father for his grace towards you in sending Jesus and saving you.
- Take some time to pray specifically for the opportunity and courage to share the gospel with someone this week.
